Filip Roca is a digital media artist known for his visually stimulating architectural projection-mapping artworks.

His practice focuses on large-scale, site-specific transformations of architecture that merge visual experimentation with spatial precision.

Since 2015, he has developed and presented architectural projection works and generative visual installations at major international festivals and cultural institutions across Europe, the Middle East, Asia, Australia, and the United States, exploring the relationship between digital imagery and built environments at scale.

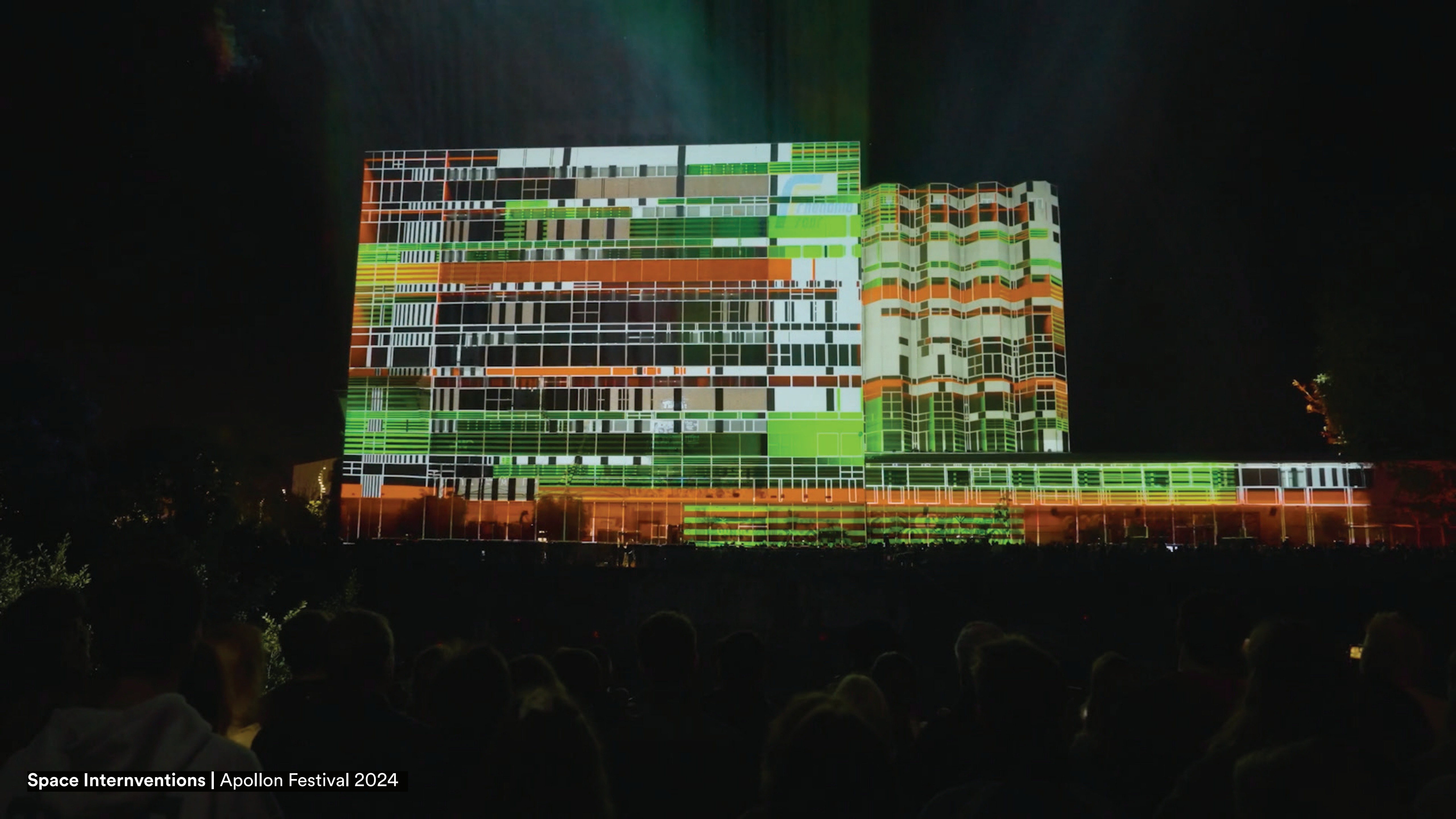




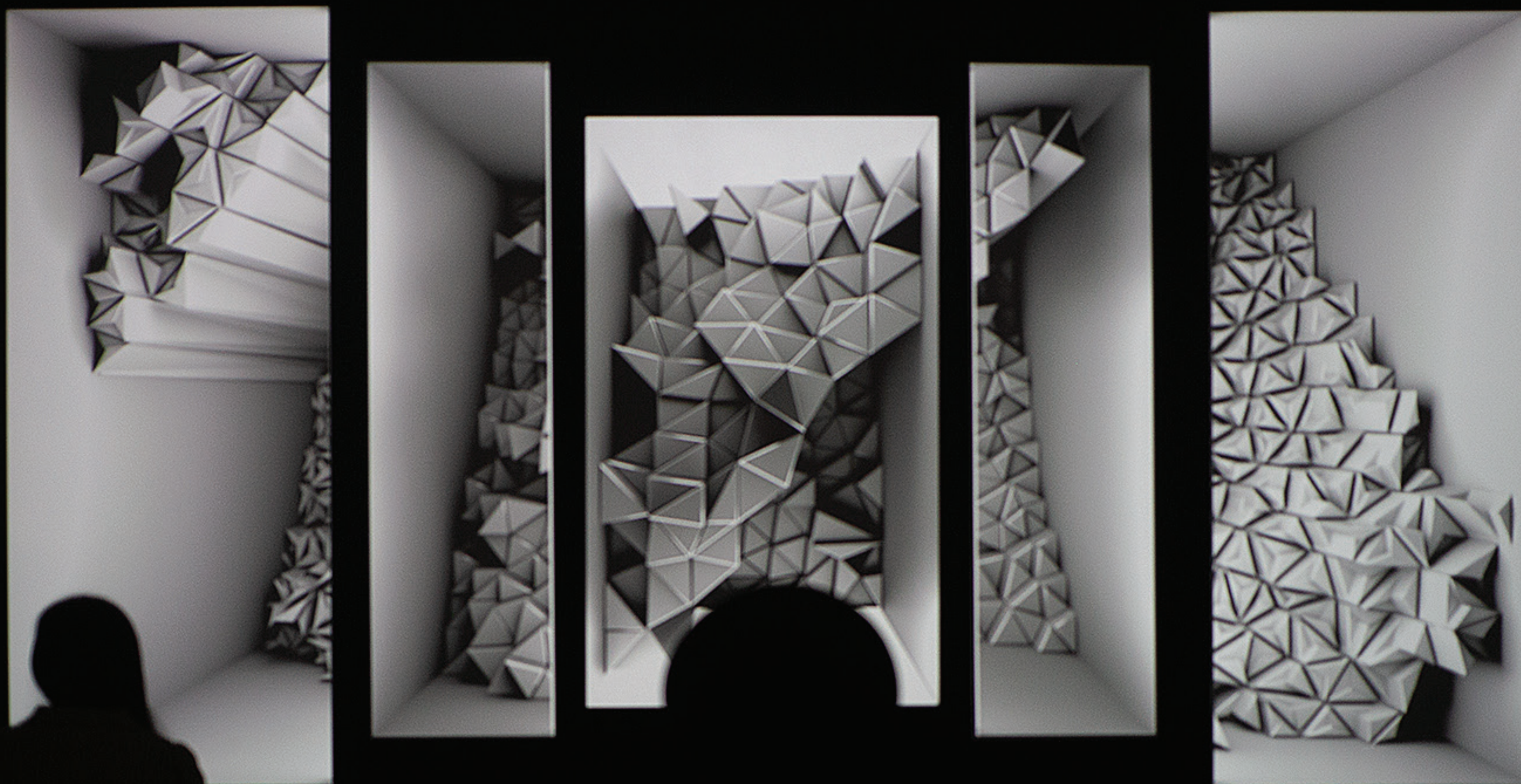














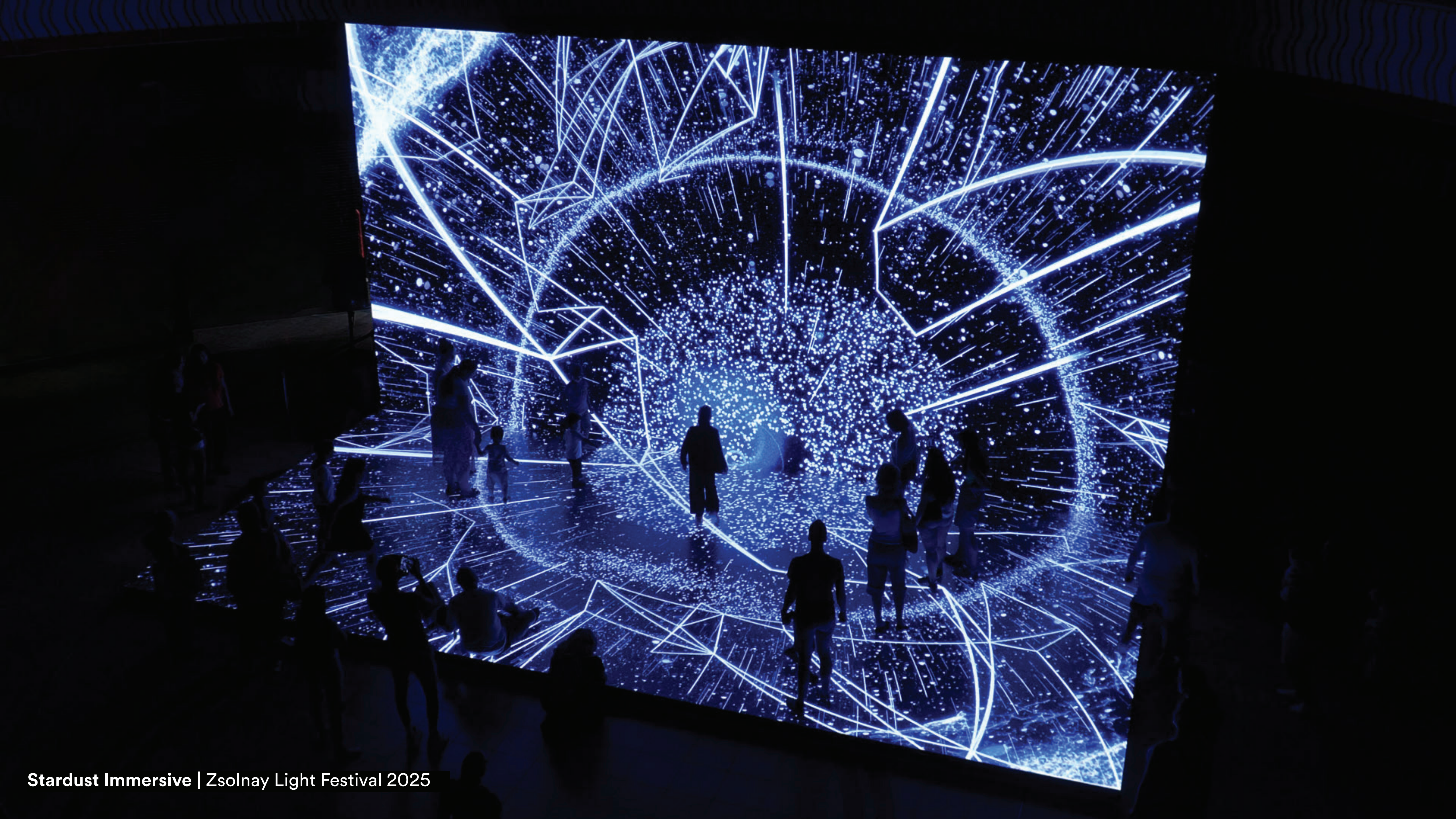
